We have an important announcement and recommendation to share.

The first gen "medical beds" are here and they work.

We have full confirmation and first-hand experience.

These particular devices are acoustical sound devices that use vibrational frequencies in the audible sound spectrum. They are totally non-invasive and safe for anyone to use, including people with metal pins and replacement joints, pacemakers and other electronic implant gadgets, and even babies and comatose patients can use this technology safely via simple adaptations.

The best way I can describe this technology which is now available to us, is computerized kinesiology.

Treatments usually take place on a table like a massage table, but can be adapted via the use of properly modulated speakers to almost any setting or environment.

The level of sound generated is not loud or intrusive and compares to the normal noise level of a radio or television set.

During treatment you simply lay down on the table, get comfortable, and remain in a relaxed position, either face up or on your stomach, whatever is comfortable.

This is barely scratching the surface of what is possible.

I don't have any known serious ailments, so I just chose the three R's --- rest, regeneration, and rejuvenation.

The first two segments were pleasant and the third was mildly irritating, but nothing I couldn't bear.

We delayed Jim's treatment for a couple days to familiarize ourselves with the whole setup and test it out, but tomorrow begins his adventure. I will keep our Assembly Family posted on his progress.
